The goal of FAST is to foster HIV and Sexual Health prevention and awareness projects throughout the NWT.

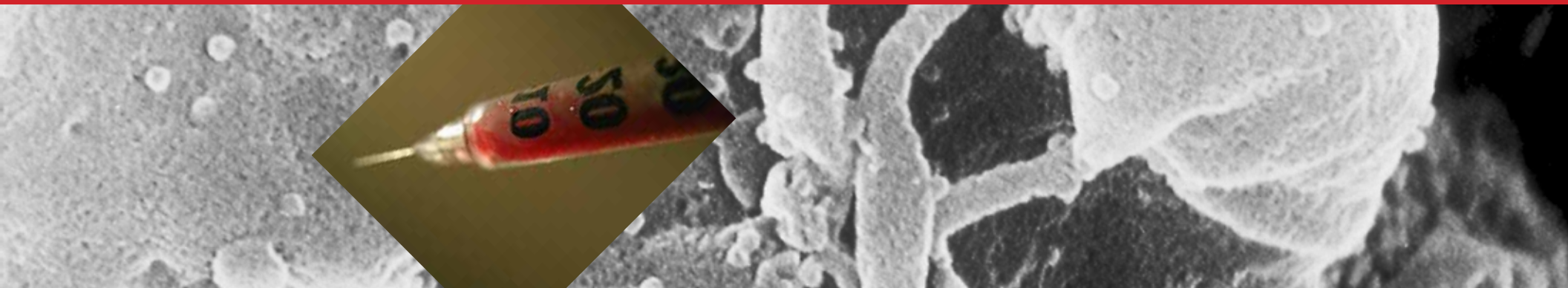


Funding
